Psalms 85: THE REVIVAL PSALM

For the director of music. Of the Sons of Korah. A psalm.

¹ You, Lord, showed favor to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. ² You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. ³ You set aside all your wrath and turned from your fierce anger.

Psalm 85:1-3

Restore us again, God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. ⁵ Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? ⁶ Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? ⁷ Show us your unfailing love, Lord, and grant us your salvation.

Psalm 85:4-7

I will listen to what God the Lord says; he promises peace to his people, his faithful servants— but let them not turn to folly. ⁹ Surely his salvation is near those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land.¹⁰ Love and faithfulness meet together; righteousness and peace kiss each other.

righteousness looks down from heaven.**

**¹² The Lord will indeed give what is good, and our land
will yield its harvest. ¹³ Righteousness goes before him

Psalm 85: The Revival Psalm

- Sons of Korah= Levites
- Written following Babylonian captivity
- became content living among the ruins instead of pursuing God and His purpose for them.
- The nation stood in great need of restoration and revival. Yet they remained content among the rubble.

“I know all the things you do. I have seen your hard work and your patient endurance. I know you don’t tolerate evil people. You have examined the claims of those who say they are apostles but are not. You have discovered they are liars.³ You have patiently suffered for me without quitting. ⁴ But I have this complaint against you. You don’t love me or each other as you did at first” (Rev.2:2-4 NLT)

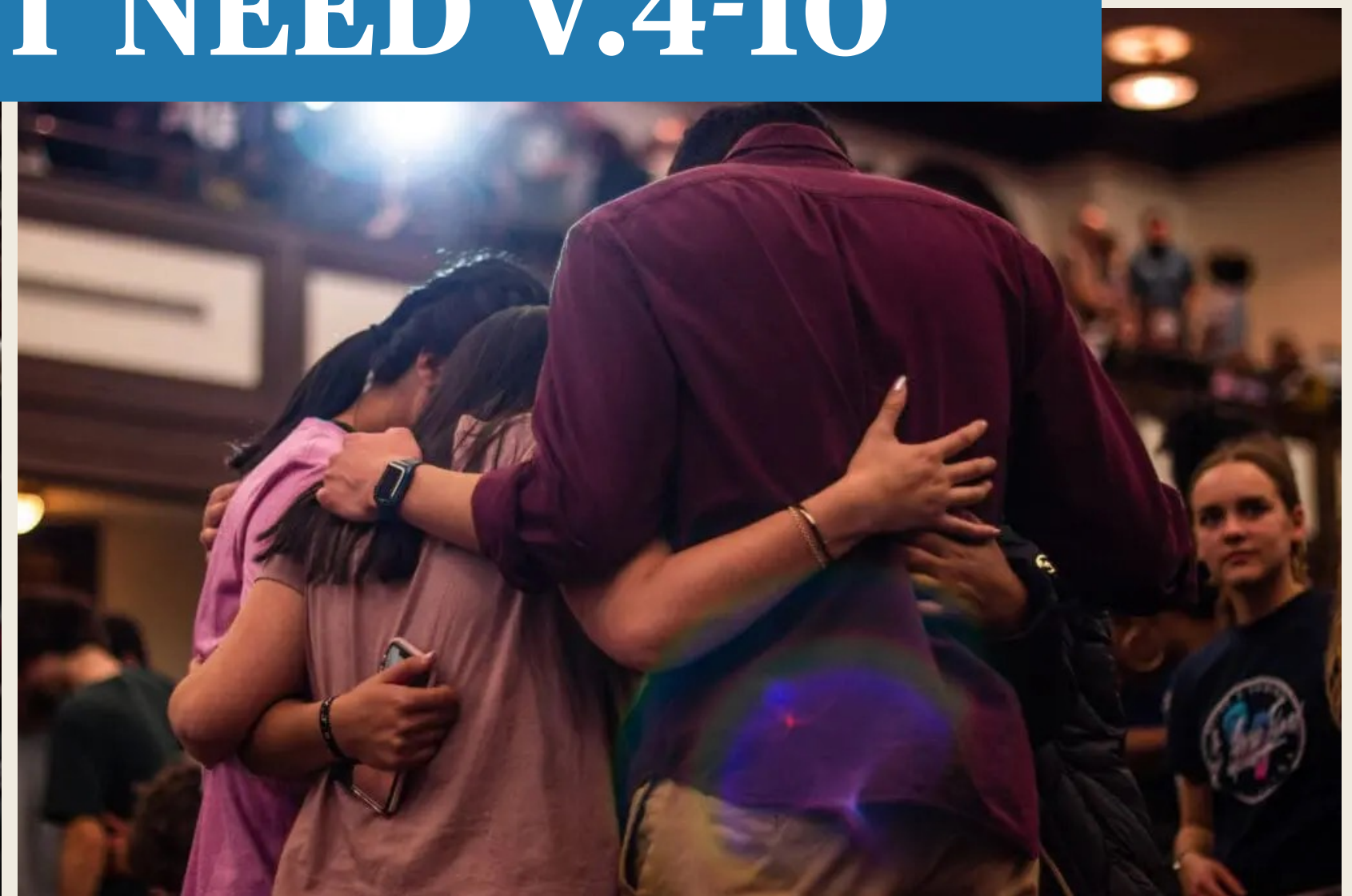

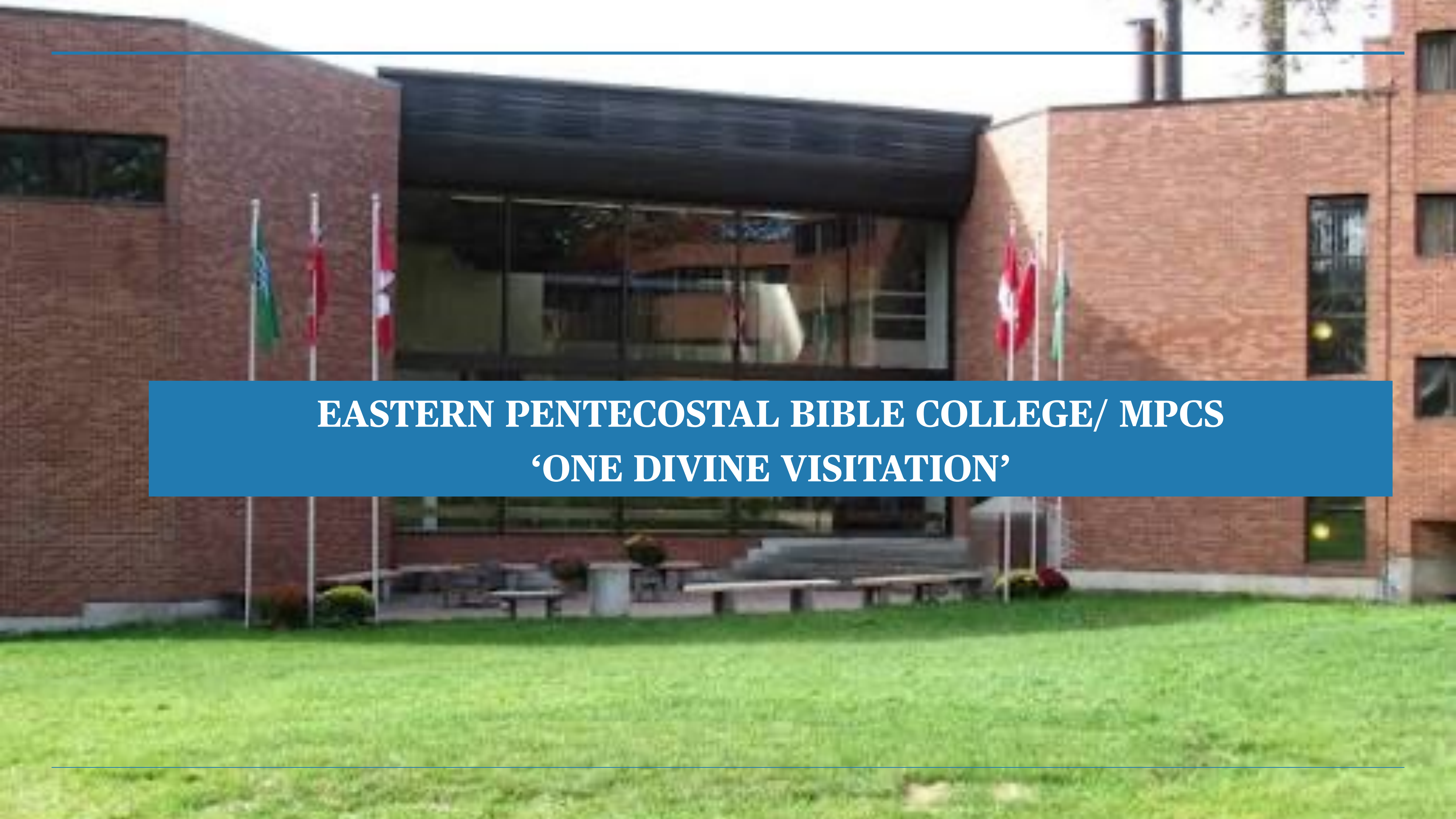
